大会经过

1. 大会主席致词

大会主席方炎华在常年会员大会上致词时感谢会员踊跃出席当天的常年会员大会及 给予本会最大的支持与合作。他表示在历届董事及永久名誉会长的领导下,本会会 务一直向上发展,青商团也快达到千名会员的目标。

他续称,今年由于2019冠状病毒疫情爆发,政府落实行动管制令(MCO),许多活动 无法举行。本会在疫情期间,捐出10万片口罩给槟州政府及献捐20万令吉给马来西 亚中华总商会(中总),以协助抗击冠病所造成的健康危机。

他希望政府能在恢复经济活动与防止病毒传播之间取得平衡点,延长自动暂缓还贷措施,降低个人所得税及公司税,协助人民及企业度过难关。国家银行也可再度降低隔夜利率,以推动面临衰退风险的经济。

他表示,政府应趁势把握机会,牵线把国际大企业引入我国设厂,同时推动更多公 共设施工程,来刺激经济。槟州政府则应加紧落实槟城国际机场扩建、轻快铁以及 提升槟城渡轮服务计划,通过这些大型计划,带动整个建筑业,刺激州内经济。

- 5) 大会吁请政府全面提升川行槟岛和北海之间的渡轮服务。
- 6) 大会吁请财政部重新检讨在2019年5月公布的《所得税法令》第44(6)条文下的豁免税务新指南。
- 7) 大会吁请交通部即刻启动槟城国际机场扩建工程计划。

槟州中华总商会 2020 年常年会员大会 会长拿督斯里方炎华 18/09/2020

大家早上好!

首先我要衷心感谢各位董事及会员拨出宝贵的时间,踊跃出席今天的常年会员大会。 我也要趁这个机会感谢各位在过去的一年来给予本会最大的支持与合作,让我们能够 顺利的完成各项活动和工作,谢谢大家。

本会在历届董事以及永久名誉会长丹斯里陈国平的英明领导下,会务一直向上发展,目前已经有超过 1000 名会员;青商会则在历任团长和现任团长李炯良带领下,也已经有超过 900 名会员,希望可以早日达到千名会员的目标。

本会于今年初曾举办与商团、华团及媒体新春聚餐会及槟中总与财政部长林冠英年初一新春大团拜,接着就遇上 2019 冠状病毒疫情爆发,政府落实行动管制令(MCO),所以许多活动都无法举行。不过,本会在疫情期间,依然关心槟州抗疫趋势,在丹斯里陈国平的号召下,捐出 10 万片口罩给槟州政府,以及捐 20 万令吉给马来西亚中华总商会(中总),以协助抗击冠病所造成的健康危机。

国家银行总裁上个月宣布,我国今年第二季度的 GDP,较去年同期下滑 17.1%,是 1998 年第四季金融风暴以来最差记录,这主要也是疫情及防疫措施所拖累。我支持政府将复原期行动管制令(RMCO)延长至 12 月 31 日,不过,政府在恢复经济活动与防止病毒传播之间必须取得平衡点,两者失其一,后果一样严重。

在实施 MCO 期间, 国家银行宣布, 所有银行从 4 月 1 日开始, 自动暂缓个人和中小企业贷款 6 个月措施, 毫无疑问的, 这政策是最实际及最能帮助到商家及人民, 让大家都能喘口气。虽然随着我国进入 RMCO 阶段, 各领域逐步有恢复的迹象, 但相信大部分商家都已经遭到重创, 没办法在短时间内恢复元气。

因此,我希望政府延长自动暂缓还贷措施,至少到今年 12 月,而非只让失业和遭减薪的人士申请,否则一旦这措施在这个月届满后,相信许多人在下个月开始就会面对困境。

今年,国家银行已经 4 度降低隔夜政策利率(OPR),最近一次是在 7 月将利率降至 1.75%,这也是历史最低点,国家银行的举动,为我国经济复苏创造有利的条件。

不过,眼看全球疫情没有减缓的迹象,加上许多国家即将迎来冬季,或会导致疫情更加严重,继而造成经济受到更大打击,因此,我希望国家银行尽快做全面的评估,或可再降低隔夜利率政策,以推动面临衰退风险的经济。

比起以往全球所面对的中美贸易战和英国脱欧,疫情是我国目前面对最大的敌人,而且现在更不能松懈,应该更谨慎面对接下来会面对的不确定性因素及挑战。

在全球经济不确定性及内忧外患的时期,政府应从危机中寻得转机,趁势把握机会,牵线把国际大企业引入我国设厂,同时在即将在11月宣布的财政预算案中,为市场及人民带来利好消息,以进一步吸引外资,塑造亲商的环境。

虽然我国的国债高企,增新税是其中一个减债的方式,但在这个市场低迷时期,已是最糟糕的选择,相反的,政府应降低个人所得税及公司税。我建议政府,年收入低于10万令吉的纳税人可免税,大企业及中小型企业的公司税降低至少2%,以协助人民及企业度过难关。

随着本地经济低迷, 亟需政府推动更多政府公共设施工程来刺激经济, 带动当前处在低迷的建筑业, 制造商机及工作机会。

我国目前依然处于"政热经冷"的局面,而这情况也是大部分会员和商家的看法,政治上的不确定性,不单让人民和商家无所适从,市场也会随之波动,投资者也只好继续观望不敢进场。

国内政治的恶性竞争,甚至操弄种族和宗教课题,让许多商家及人民对经济前景感到担忧,或许国盟政府可考虑在短期内举行大选,让人民重新做出选择,一劳永逸解决目前的政治困境,通过稳定的政府,制定亲商政策,做好国家建设。

此外, 我希望槟州政府在制定槟州财政预算案时, 注重在中下阶层的福利及就业机会, 同时通过减免税务的政策, 鼓励外国和本地投资, 为槟州带来更多投资和制作更多就 业机会。

虽然全球的经济目前处于衰退的迹象,但危机中总会有转机,我希望槟州政府应该趁这个时候,加紧落实三大公共交通计划,即槟城国际机场扩建计划、轻快铁计划以及提升槟城渡轮服务计划,通过这些大型计划,带动整个建筑业,刺激州内经济。

我相信在疫情稳定后,槟州的旅游业、医疗旅游及航空业会迅速恢复。在槟城国际机场在疫情爆发前已经饱和的情况下,交通部不应该把槟城国际机场扩建计划纳入在国家机场策略计划(NASP)的研究,反而应加速扩建,让复苏槟州经济的道路事半功倍。

我希望政府能慎重考虑以上几点建议,引领人民渡过这艰难的时期。最后,我再次感谢各位对槟中总的支持。并谨祝大家身体健康,事业进步,谢谢!

1. 政府应尽快拟定行管令后的振兴经济计划

大会吁请政府尽快拟定行管令后的振兴经济计划。

案由: 新冠肺炎引发全球性的灾难。各国政府相继采取各项管制措施,严重的影响人流与物流的活动,几乎瘫痪全球经济。

最近,首相慕尤丁宣布,复苏式行管令(RMCO)将从8月31日延长至12月31日。我国从3月18日开始,经历了四个阶段的行管令(MCO),有条件行管令(CMCO)及从6月10日开始的复苏式行管令(RMCO)。

过去 5 个月,大家的生活作息已经改变,大家都很努力适应新冠肺炎带来的新常态。但是,商业与经济活动还是处于低迷的状态,须要政府当局的全面推动,特 别是各项津贴,奖掖措施等。

1. Economic Revitalization Plan after Administration Order Expeditiously

We call on the government to draw up an economic revitalization plan expeditiously after end of movement control order (MCO) period.

Rationale: The Covid-19 pandemic has caused a global disaster. Governments of various countries have successively adopted various control measures, which seriously affected the movement of people and logistics, and almost paralyzed the global economy.

Recently, Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin announced the extension of RMCO from 31 August to 31 December 2020. Since 18 March, our nation has gone through four phases of Movement Control Order (MCO), Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) and Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) starting on 10 June 2020.

In the past 5 months, everyone's lifestyle has changed. Everybody is trying hard to adapt to the new normal brought by Covid-19. However, commercial and economic activities are still in a sluggish state and require proactive promotion by the government, especially in providing various subsidies and incentives.

2. 加强宽频网络覆盖层面及提供高素质网络服务

大会吁请政府全面加强我国的宽频网络覆盖层面及服务质量,以提供稳定、快速与高素质的有线与无线网络服务,促进各行各业更广泛的应用网络服务。

案由:新冠疫情后的新常态出现新契机,居家办公等弹性工作方式、网络购物及线上学习等也开始普及。然而,由于网络缓慢,影响到各项活动的顺利操作。因此,政府必须尽快的提供高速网络及提升其覆盖率。

2. Strengthen Broadband Network Coverage and Provide High-Quality Network Services

We urge the Government to strengthen the broadband network coverage and provide high quality service throughout the country in order to provide stable, fast and high-quality wired and wireless network services. At the same time promote wider application of network services in all walks of life.

Rationale: New opportunities emerge in the new normal after the Covid-19 pandemic. Flexible working methods such as working from home, online shopping and online learning become a new normal. With the slow internet, on-line activities are seriously affected. Therefore, it is timely that the Government should improve high-speed network coverage timeously in order not to hinder on-line activities.

3. 重新启动大马第二家园计划(MM2H)

大会吁请政府重新启动大马第二家园计划(MM2H), 引进更多外汇, 吸引人才, 以便在疫情下尽快恢复经济发展。

案由:政府宣布第二家园计划(MM2H)暂停至明年,导致我国经济再次受损。参与这项计划的人多为各领域精英,他们前来置业带动大马经济,带动外资进入我国,也同时带动了教育、保险、金融和地产等领域。

3. Reactivate the Malaysia My Second Home Programme (MM2H)

We urge the Government to reactivate the Malaysia My Second Home Programme (MM2H) in order to attract more foreign exchange and talents, which will help to resume and boost economic development as soon as possible.

Rationale: The government announced that MM2H plan has been suspended until next year, causing our country's economy to suffer again. Most of the people participating in this programme are elites in various fields. They come to buy properties to drive the Malaysian economy and bring in foreign capital to our country. Their arrival has also promoted education, insurance, finance and real estate.

4. 关注旅游业,包括医药旅游业者的难题与困境

大会吁请政府关注旅游业,包括医药旅游业者所面对的各项难题与困境,尽快推出补助措施,让业者尽快渡过难关。

案由:新冠肺炎疫情的暴发对全球经济造成了严重影响,旅游业可以说首当其冲。签证受限、航班停飞、边界关闭、社交隔离诸如此类的措施使全球的旅游业几乎陷入完全停摆状态。航空公司、旅行社、酒店、景点等旅游相关服务产业进入了一个前所未有的大萧条时期,庞大旅游从业人员的生计因此受到严重影响。

4. <u>Attention to Problems and Plights of Tourism Industry, Including Medical Tourism Industry</u>

We urge the Government to pay attention to the problems and plights of tourism industry, including medical tourism industry, by introducing subsidy measures so that the industry can tide over the difficulties the soonest possible.

Rationale: The outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic has had a serious impact on the global economy and tourism industry is the one to bear the brunt. Visa restrictions, flight suspensions, border closures, social distancing and other measures have brought the global tourism industry into an almost complete shutdown. The tourism-related service industries such as airlines, travel agencies, hotels and attractions have entered an unprecedented period of Great Depression and the livelihoods of tourism employees have been severely affected.

5. 全面提升川行槟岛和北海之间的渡轮服务

大会吁请政府全面提升川行槟岛和北海之间的渡轮服务。

案由: 川行槟岛和北海之间的渡轮服务,在 1920 年启用,今年服务满 100 年,是属于槟城州的历史性标志。然而,自从两座大桥启用后,渡轮的使用率减少了。这也造成渡轮的营运连年亏蚀。根据报告槟城渡轮每年开销约 3100 万令吉,但年收入只有 700 万令吉,亏损 2400 万令吉。残旧的渡轮需更昂贵的维修经费,让渡轮营运备受压力。

渡轮服务依然是一项不可缺少的公共服务,是通往槟岛与北海的重要公共交通工具。近日,联邦政府宣布拨款3千万令吉以购买新的渡轮。我们希望这个好消息可以在最短的时间内实现。

5. Improvement of Ferry Service Between Penang Island and Butterworth

We urge the Government to improve the ferry service between Penang Island and Butterworth comprehensively.

Rationale: The ferry service between Penang Island and Butterworth was launched in year 1920 and it has been serving for 100 years now. It is a historic landmark of Penang. However, since the advent of the 2 Penang bridges, the use of ferries to commute has lost its popularity and the operation has reported losses for years.

According to the report of PPSB, Penang ferry service's annual expenses is about RM31 million, but the annual income is only RM7 million and the loss is RM24 million. Dilapidated ferries require more expensive repairs, putting pressure on ferry operations

The ferry service is still an indispensable public service and an important means of public transportation to Penang Island and Butterworth. Recently, the Federal Government announced an allocation of RM30 million to purchase new ferries. We hope this good news can be realized in the shortest time.

6. 慈善机构应获第 44 (6) 条文豁免纳税资格

大会吁请财政部重新检讨在2019年5月公布的《所得税法令》第44(6)条文下的豁免税务新指南。

案由: 2019年5月公布的新条文干扰了非营利慈善机构 (好像医院等)的运作。

最近,内陆税收局对获批准的非营利慈善机构进行税收审核。

在此过程中,许多既定获批准的慈善组织/非政府组织已被撤销其第44(6)条文豁免地位。这些非政府组织也失去了附表3第13(1)(a)段的收入豁免纳税。

在这方面, 我们呼吁财政部重新考虑其新政策。

此外,内陆税收局应就其新指南与所有获批准的非营利慈善机构/非政府组织进行对话。

规定非政府组织用以推展慈善事业的资金收入/利润缴交税务, 是毫无意义的。

6. Section 44(6) Exemption For Charitable Organizations

We urge the Ministry of Finance to review the new guidelines for approving Section 44(6) exemption pursuant to Income Tax Act issued in May 2019.

Rationale: The new guidelines issued in May 2019 have disturbed the works of the charitable bodies such as not-for-profit hospitals.

Recently, the IRB has been carrying out tax audit on the approved organizations.

In this process, many established approved organisations / NGOs carrying out charitable activities have got their Section 44(6) approval revoked. These NGOs have also lost their Schedule 3 Para 13(1)(a) exemption on their incomes.

In this respect, we would urge the Ministry of Finance to relook into their new policy.

Further, the IRB should conduct a dialogue with all approved organisations / NGOs regarding their new guidelines.

It does not make sense for an NGO to pay tax for gains/profits generated to finance the charitable work it performs for the benefit of the community.

7. 槟城国际机场扩建工程

大会吁请交通部即刻启动槟城国际机场扩建工程计划。

案由: 槟州国际机场扩建工程于 2019 年获得槟岛市政厅批准, 并计划于今年动工。但是有报道称该工程需等待国家机场战略计划 (NASP)重新研究, 而该研究需在 2023 年才完成。我们赞同槟州政府的观点,即槟州国际机场扩建工程应该尽早开展。由于客运容量已超过负荷,提升是必要的。 此外,机场现在的状况并不能彰显槟城作为国际城市的形象。

7. Expansion of Penang International Airport (PIA)

We urge the Ministry of Transport to commence the extension project of the Penang International Airport which has been approved.

Rationale: The planned expansion of the PIA has been approved by MBPP since Year 2019 and was scheduled to start this year. However it was reported that this expansion has been put on hold pending a new study under the National Airport Strategic Plan (NASP) which can only be completed in 2023. We agree with the Penang State Government that the PIA Expansion Plan is long overdue and necessary to be implemented now as the airport has exceeded its maximum capacity. In addition, the current situation of the airport does not portray well of the image of Penang as an international city.

1. ADDRESS BY THE CHAIRMAN

The Chairman Hong Yeam Wah in his address expressed his gratitude to all PCCC members for setting aside their valuable time to attend the AGM and rendered their supports and cooperation to the Chamber. He said that PCCC had grown steadily under the enlightened leadership of all previous and current Committees and Life Honorary President. PCCC YES was also nearly reaching the goal of 1,000 members.

He added that due to the outbreak of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic this year and the government announced the Movement Control Order (MCO), many activities were unable to be held. During the pandemic period, PCCC had donated 100,000 face masks to Penang State Government and raised RM200,000.00 for donation to The Associated Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Malaysia (ACCCIM) as The Edge Covid-19 Fund to fight against the disease.

He hoped that the government could strike a balance between resuming economic activities and preventing the outbreak of virus, extend the automatic deferment of personal/SMEs loan/financing repayments program, reduce personal tax and company tax to help the people and enterprises overcome this difficult period. BNM might cut the OPR further to boost the economy which was facing recession risk.

He opined that the government should take advantages of the opportunity to bring in multinational companies into our country to set up factories and put in more efforts to optimize national construction, improve the people's livelihood and stimulate the economy. The Penang State Government should speed up the Penang International Airport (PIA) expansion plan, Light Rail Transit (LRT) system and improvement of the current ferry service between Penang Island and Butterworth.

5. DISCUSSION ON MOTIONS SUBMITTED BY MEMBERS

The meeting adopted the 7 motions submitted by members as follows:

- 1. We call on the government to draw up an economic revitalization plan expeditiously after end of movement control order (MCO) period.
- 2. We urge the Government to strengthen the broadband network coverage and provide high quality service throughout the country in order to provide stable, fast and high-quality wired and wireless network services. At the same time promote wider application of network services in all walks of life.
- 3. We urge the Government to reactivate the Malaysia My Second Home Programme (MM2H) in order to attract more foreign exchange and talents, which will help to resume and boost economic development as soon as possible.
- 4. We urge the Government to pay attention to the problems and plights of tourism industry, including medical tourism industry, by introducing subsidy measures so that the industry can tide over the difficulties the soonest possible.
- 5. We urge the Government to improve the ferry service between Penang Island and Butterworth comprehensively.
- 6. We urge the Ministry of Finance to review the new guidelines for approving Section 44(6) exemption pursuant to Income Tax Act issued in May 2019.
- 7. We urge the Ministry of Transport to commence the extension project of the Penang International Airport which has been approved

PENANG CHINESE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE 2020 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING Speech by Dato' Seri Hong Yeam Wah

Speech by Dato' Seri Hong Yeam Wah 18/09/2020

A good morning to all of you!

First of all, I would like to express my gratitude to all PCCC General Committee and members for setting aside precious time and enthusiastically attending today's AGM. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for giving us the greatest support and cooperation in the past year so that we could successfully complete all our activities and jobs smoothly, thank you.

PCCC grew steadily under the enlightened leadership of all previous and current Committees and Life Honorary President Tan Sri Tan Kok Ping. To date, we have around 10,000 direct and indirect members. Under the leadership of PCCC YES past Chairman and current Chairman, Lee Toong Leon, PCCC Young Entrepreneur Section has reached more than 900 members. I hope PCCC YES members could reach the goal of 1,000 members in the short time.

After hosting the Chinese New Year Dinner with various associations and the press and the CNY Open House with Finance Minister Tuan Lim Guan Eng for various associations and all ethnic groups on the 1st day of Chinese New Year, Malaysia reported the outbreak of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic and the government announced the Movement Control Order (MCO), therefore many activities were unable to be held. However, during the pandemic period, PCCC was still concerned about the situation of COVID-19 outbreak in Penang. During MCO period, Tan Sri Tan Kok Ping called up to donate 100,000 face masks to Penang State Government and raised RM200, 000.00 for donation to The Associated Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Malaysia (ACCCIM) as The Edge Covid-19 Fund to fight against the disease.

Last month, the Governor of Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) announced that Malaysia's GDP fell 17.1% in the second-quarter of 2020 from the same period last year, lowest since financial crisis in the fourth quarter in 1998. This is mainly dragged down by the COVID-19 pandemic and pandemic prevention measures. I support the Malaysian Government for extension of Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) until 31 December 2020, however, the government should strike a balance between resuming economic activities and preventing the outbreak of virus, if either one failed, the consequences will be equally serious.

During Movement Control Order (MCO), BNM announced that effective 1 April 2020, all banking institutions will provide an automatic deferment of personal/SMEs loan/financing repayments for a period of 6 months. There is no doubt that this policy is most practical and helpful to business and community, and everyone can take a breath. Although Malaysia is at RMCO stage, there are signs of recovery in various fields, but I believe most of businesses have been hit hard and there is no way to recovery in short period.

Therefore, I hope that Government will extend the automatic deferment of personal/SMEs loan/financing repayments program at least until 31 December 2020, instead of just allow those losses of employment/income and pay cut to apply. Otherwise, once the program expires in September, I believe many people will start facing difficulties the next month

BNM has cut the overnight policy rate (OPR) four times this year, the most recent time was cut it to 1.75% in July. This is the lowest rate in history, the action taken by BNM is to create favorable conditions for recovery our economy.

However, as the global epidemic is showing no signs of slowing down and winter is approaching many countries, the epidemic may become more serious and the economy will be hit harder.

Therefore I hope that the BNM will make a comprehensive assessment as soon as possible, or it may cut the OPR further, to boost the economy which is facing recession risk.

Compared with the China-United States trade war and Brexit that the world has faced in the past, the epidemic is the biggest enemy facing by our country now, we cannot relax at this moment, we should be more cautious in facing the uncertainties and challenges that we are going to face.

In times of global economy is being hit by uncertainty and facing internal and external problems, the government should find a turning point from the crisis and take the advantages of the opportunity to bring multinational companies into our country to set up factories. Meanwhile, in the financial budget to be announced in November, it should bring good news to help the market and people to further attract foreign investment and create a pro-business environment.

Although our national debts is high and impose new tax is one of the ways to reduce the debts, but during an economy downturn, it is a worst choice. On the contrary, the government should reduce personal tax and company tax. I suggest that tax payers with annual income less than RM100, 000 should be exempted from tax and the Government should reduce the corporate tax of large enterprises and SMEs by at least 2% to help the people and enterprises overcome this difficult period.

With the local economic downturn, there is an urgent need for the government to promote more public facilities and projects to stimulate the economy and drive the current downturn in the construction industry, create business and job opportunities.

Our country is still in a situation of "hot politics and cold economy", and this is also views of most members and businesses. Political uncertainty not only makes people and businesses at a loss, the market will also fluctuate and investors continue to wait and see and dare not enter the market

The vicious competition in local politics and even the manipulation of racial and religious issues have caused many businesses and people worry about the economic prospects. Perhaps the Perikatan Nasional government may consider holding a general election in the short term to allow the people to make new choices and solve the current political dilemma once and for all. A stable government can formulate pro-business policies and do a good job in nation construction.

In addition, I hope that Penang State Government would emphasize the welfare and employment opportunities of lower middle class income earners when drafting Penang state budget. At the same time, encourage and bring in more foreign and local investments through reduction of tax to create more job opportunities for Penang.

Although the global economy is currently in signs of recession, but there will always be a turning point in crisis, I hope that the Penang State Government could take advantage of this time to implement the three major Transport Plans, i.e. expansion of Penang International Airport (PIA), Light Rail Transit (LRT) system and improvement of the current ferry service between Penang Island and Butterworth. Through these large-scale plans, it can drive the construction sector and stimulate the state economy.

I believe that after stabilization of the pandemic, Penang tourism, medical tourism and flights will resume operation rapidly. PIA has hit the maximum capacity before the outbreak of covid-19 pandemic. The Ministry of Transport should exclude Penang International Airport expansion plan from the National Airport Strategic Plan (NASP) study. On the contrary, it should speed up the expansion plan and make the road to recovery of Penang's economy more effective.

I hope the government will carefully consider the above suggestions and guide the people through this difficult period. Finally, I would like to thank you again for your support to PCCC and I wish everyone good health, continued success and prosperity, thank you!

收视财政预算案公布之现场直播

槟中总执行董事及经济、财务及税务组于 2020 年 11 月 6 日(星期五)下午 4 时,在槟中总会议室收视财政部长公布国家财政预算案之现场直播,并在财政部长宣布过后,即对预算案作出评估及向报界发表意见,以反映槟中总之观点和见解。全文如下:

槟州中华总商会形容 2021 年度国家财政预算案为非常时期的非常预算案,基本上是一份大家意料中的预算案。

在这之前,政府已经推出了 4 个总额高达 3,050 亿令吉的 PRIHATIN 和 PENJANA 的经济配套。而 2021 年度国家财政预算案基本上是延续上面的四个经济配套。

原本这个财政预算案应该是配合 第 12 个五年大马计划而拟定的预算案,是未来五年国家经济的起跑点,可惜,由于疫情的爆发而打乱整个国家,乃至于全世界的经济规划。这导致了政府只能够专注于处理当前困境,打出以"同心协力,并肩制胜"为主题的预算案。

正如财长东姑扎夫鲁所形容, 2020 年对于全球来说是艰巨挑战的一年, 对于马来西亚来说也是"前所未有的危机"。因此, 2021 年财政预算案将着重于 3 个主要目标: 人民福祉、商业延续性及经济活动。槟中总认为政府锁定这三个主题是无可厚非, 而且务实的作风。

这次的预算案,基本上没有任何重大税务改变,工商界也没有获得税务上的特别优惠。而所宣布的 优惠基本上是针对性,给予 B-40 及 M-40 群体的援助。我们欢迎受惠群体可以获得直接援助,舒缓 生活的困苦.同时也可以刺激商业活动.为商家带来一些收入。

槟中总在文告中特别强调:"我们非常欢迎财长在预算案中一次过宣布,从 2021 年到 2025 年期间,第一次购买 50 万令吉以下的房产者可以获得豁免印花税。这是一个非常正面和积极的决定,可以带动房地产的持续发展。"

另外,槟中总肯定政府为迁厂到马来西亚和进行新投资的特定厂商,提供特别税率,包括享有 10 年优惠税率。财长宣布这项措施将延长一年,直到 2022 年 12 月 31 日为止。

因应疫情的发展趋势,政府鼓励制药厂的投资给予税务的奖励,政府也在同时认真看待医药旅游作 为一项新的投资来源,通过医药旅游理事会采取措施提高这个领域的竞争力。

最后,对于 2021 财政预算案,整体上而言,槟州中华总商会认为这是一份可以被接受的预算案。我们恳切的希望建议中的各项惠民政策,可以尽快落实。







PCCC 2020 Annual General Meeting

Live Telecast Viewing of Budget Speech

PCCC Executive Committee Members and Economics, Finance & Taxation Committee organized a live telecast viewing of the national budget speech by the Finance Minister on Friday, 6 November 2020 at 4:00pm at PCCC Meeting Room to evaluate the budget and thereafter issue a press release to reflect the Chamber's views and comments as follows:

PCCC views the National Budget 2021 as an extraordinary budget in an extraordinary period. It is basically a budget that is expected by everyone.

Before the announcement of the budget, the government has launched 4 economic stimulus packages of PRIHATIN and PENJANA with a total value of RM305 billion.

This Budget was supposed to be planned in line with the 12th Malaysian Plan which would kick start the country's economy for the next five years, but unfortunately, the outbreak of the covid-19 pandemic has disrupted such planning. The government has no other option, but to focus on dealing with the current situation and to come up with a budget which is based on the theme of "Stand United, We Shall Prevail".

The Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul has aptly described that 2020 is the year of great challenges for the world and an "unprecedented crisis" for Malaysia. Thus, the 2021 budget placed emphasis on 3 main themes: The Wellbeing of the People, Business Continuity and Resilience of the Economy. PCCC is of the view that the approach taken is understandable and pragmatic.

In this Budget, there are basically no major tax changes and the business sector does not receive any special tax concessions. The handouts announced are basically targeted at the B40 and M40 groups. We hoped that the beneficiaries will receive direct assistance to alleviate their hardship, while at the same time stimulating business activities and generating some revenue for the business community.

PCCC welcomes the Finance Minister's proposal in the Budget that gives stamp duty exemption to the 1st time home buyer in respect of houses pricing below RM500,000. This exemption is given for a period of 5 years from 2021 to 2025. This is a very positive and pragmatic decision that will drive the continuous development of the property sector.

Besides, PCCC praised the government's tax incentive, including a 10-year concessionary tax rate for specific manufacturers that relocate their factories to Malaysia and make the new investments. The Finance Minister announced that the measure would be extended for one more year until 31 December 2022.

In response to the rapid spread of the pandemic, the government is providing tax incentive to pharmaceutical sector to expand and invest. The government is also taking medical tourism seriously as a new source of investment and Malaysia Healthcare Travel Council is tasked to enhance competitiveness in this sector.

In conclusion, PCCC opines that the 2021 Budget is generally acceptable. We fervently hope that all the measures in the Budget that benefit the people will be put into action soonest possible.

PCCC Charity Fund Committee Extraordinary General Meeting

In order to comply with Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) formulated by the Ministry of Health to prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, and in response to the encouragement by the Registrar of Societies to organize virtual meetings to avoid any form of gathering, PCCC Charity Fund Committee Extraordinary General Meeting was held via ZOOM video conferencing on Tuesday, 1 December 2020 at 12 noon. The live stream venue of the SGM was at PCCC Tan Kok Ping Hall.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - 31 DECEMBER 2020

1. PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the Association are to improve and develop trade and industry, collect and distribute commercial information and issue certificates of authentication, arbitrate and settle trade and industrial disputes, collect and compile trade statistics and hold trade exhibitions and sponsor charitable works. There have been no significant change in the nature of these activities during the financial year.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

2.1 Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Association have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with the MASB Approved Accounting Standards in Malaysia for Private Entities in all material resepcts.

2.2 Depreciation

Depreciation of property, plant and equipment is on a straight line basis calculated to write-off the cost over their expected useful lives.

The principal annual rates used for this purpose are as follows:

Furniture, fittings and equipment	10%
Office equipment	10%
Office renovation	20%
Computer and Software	40%

No amortisation has been made in respect of the freehold buildings as the directors are unable to segregate the cost of the buildings from that of the land. This is not in compliance with Malaysian Accounting Standard No. 14 which requires buildings to be amortised.

2.3 Subscriptions

Subscriptions are taken up on cash basis.

2.4 Rental Income

Rental income is accounted for on accrual basis.

2.5 Fixed Deposit Interest Received

Fixed deposit interest is recognised on cash receipt basis.

2.6 Chantable Funds

Chantable funds consist of unrestricted funds and restricted funds.

Unrestricted funds is a general fund that is available for use at the Executive Committee's discretion in furtherance to the objectives of the Association Restricted funds are subject to particular purposes imposed by the donor or by nature of appeal. They are not available for use in other Association's activities or purposes.

2.7 Income Tax

Income tax on the profit or loss for the year comprises of current and deferred tax. Current tax is the expected amount of income taxes payable in respect of the taxable profit for the year and is measured using the tax rates that have been enacted at the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax is provided for, using the liability method, on temporary differences at the balance sheet date between the tax bases of assets and liabilities and their carrying amounts in the financial statements. In principle, deferred tax liabilities are recognised for all taxable temporary differences and deferred tax assets are recognised for all deductible temporary differences, unused tax losses and unused tax credits to the extent that it is probable that taxable profit will be available against which the deductible temporary differences, unused tax losses and unused tax credit can be utilised. Deferred tax is not recognised if the temporary difference arises from goodwill or negative goodwill or from initial recognition of an asset or liability in a transaction which is not a business combination and at the time of the transaction, affects neither accounting profit nor taxable profit.

2.8 Cash and Cash Equivalent

Cash and cash equivalents include cash in hand and at bank which have an insignificant risk of changes in value, net of outstanding bank overdrafts, if any.

2.9 Receivables

Receivables are carried at anticipated realisable values. Bad debts are written off when identified. An estimate is made for doubtful debts based on a review of all outstanding amounts as at the balance sheet date.

3.0 Payables

Payables are stated at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in future for goods and services rendered.
